Stroll through the small streets of Billio to discover the wrought iron signs.

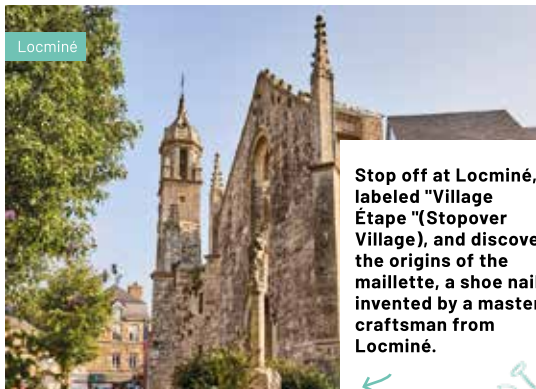


Billio



Guéhenno

Take a detour to Guéhenno, labeled "Commune du Patrimoine Rural de Bretagne", to see the only monumental calvary in Morbihan.

Climb the famous hill of Cadoudal in Plumelec to compete with the greats of cycling.

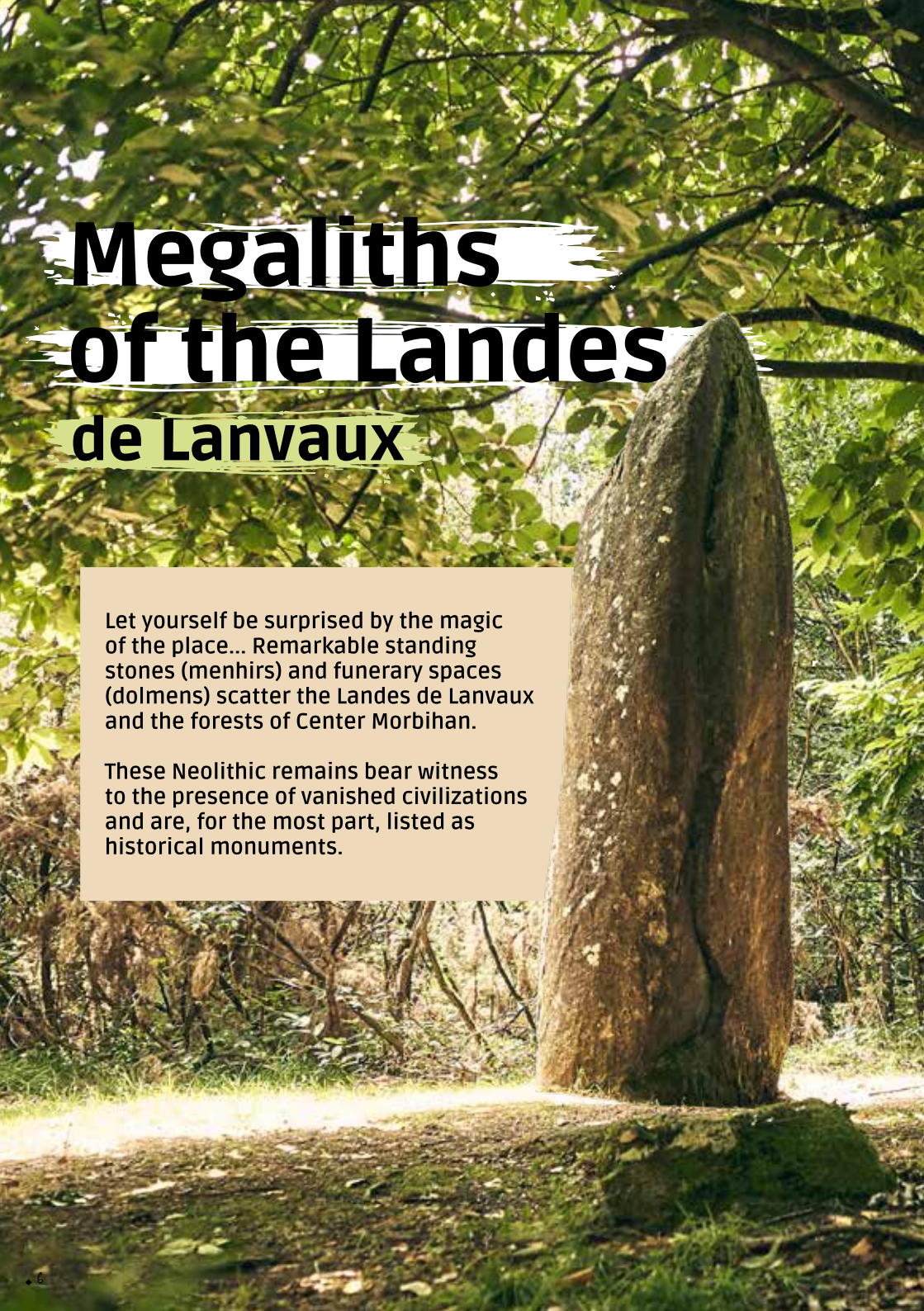


Plumelec

Megaliths of the Landes de Lanvaux

Let yourself be surprised by the magic of the place... Remarkable standing stones (menhirs) and funerary spaces (dolmens) scatter the Landes de Lanvaux and the forests of Center Morbihan.

These Neolithic remains bear witness to the presence of vanished civilizations and are, for the most part, listed as historical monuments.

« The Landes de Lanvaux stretch over 70 km in length and are home to nearly 400 megaliths »

Kermarquer menhir

From a height of 6.72 meters, you are being observed by almost 6,500 years of history ! The Landes de Lanvaux shelter the highest still standing and listed historic monument menhir in Morbihan in Moustoir-Ac : the Kermarquer menhir. Its height is not the only special thing about it : it also bears engravings (7 crooks and 2 horn shapes) which discreetly appear to the eye in the evening light.

Covered alley of Kergonfalz

Located on the Vélo Promenade® route n°35 in Bignan, the covered alley measures 9.50 meters long and 1.50 meters wide. Listed historic monument in 1970, it is made up of 12 vertical stones supporting three roof slabs. The tumulus which covered it, as well as one of the slabs located in the north (cella), have completely disappeared.

Covered alley of Roh Koh Koët

The covered alley of Roh Koh Koët in Saint-Jean-Brévelay, listed historic monument is an ingenious burial monument built into the outcrop of a natural rock. Overlooking the valley of the Claie, this exceptional covered alley, also called dolmen of Kerhern Bodunan, has an east-west orientation.

Goeh Menhir menhir

With its 6 meters high, Goeh Menhir menhir is the highest of Saint-Jean-Brévelay. Its name indicates its location in a humid environment, «goeh» in Breton meaning stream or marsh.

Architectural treasures

The Centre Morbihan is rich in architectural heritage. Chapels, calvaries, crosses, and granite fountains are everywhere: on mountaintops, at crossroads, in small villages...

Some chapels open their doors thanks to the mobilization of volunteers or during cultural events.

Team advice

«After visiting the monumental Calvary of Guéhenno, don't hesitate to visit the place of the Mont, which houses a chapel and a windmill. It's an ideal spot for family picnics, with, in good weather, a breathtaking view over the Brocéliande forest.»



Notre-Dame-des-Flours Chapel

At Evellys, in the village of Moric, the Notre-Dame-des-Flours chapel (16th century) houses several polychrome statues and contemporary stained-glass windows donated by the artist David Tremlett. Each summer, the chapel welcomes an artist as part of the festival «Art in the chapels».

Sainte-Noyale Chapel

The town of Bignan is full of crosses and chapels. The Sainte-Noyale chapel (15th century) is worth a visit to admire its listed statues dating from the 15th to the 18th centuries.

«When the calvaries light up...»
The calvary regularly regains its original colours through a sound and light show initiated by the Association of the 7 monumental calvaries of Brittany.



Birthplace of Pierre Guillemot

The house where the «King of Bignan» was born in 1759 is a representation of a farm belonging to a wealthy peasant at the end of the 18th century: thatched roof, staircase and mullioned shelf.

Saint-Maurice Church

The Saint-Maurice church in Plumelec features exceptional string-pieces made in the 16th century by the Nivet brothers. These high-relief wooden sculptures deliver a divine message in which fantastical creatures rub shoulders with men and their sins.

Guéhenno labeled «Commune du Patrimoine Rural de Bretagne»

Listed historical monument, the only monumental Calvary in Morbihan is located in Guéhenno. Treasure of Breton architecture built in the heart of a parish enclosure, the granite Calvary tells the story of the Passion of Christ and the Breton Chouannerie. Built in 1550, it was destroyed during the French Revolution and then restored in 1853 by Abbot Jacquot and his vicar, Abbot Laumaillet.

The 16th century Saint-Michel Chapel rises to 147 meters on the site of the Mont. At the heart of the chapel is a wooden statue of the Archangel Saint-Michel brandishing his flaming sword and slaying the dragon. Keep your eyes peeled for the dragon heads, symbols of the seven deadly sins. Stroll through the alleys following the «Granite Tells Its Story» walking trail.

Sainte-Anne Chapel

The Sainte-Anne chapel in Buléon preserves two remarkable polychrome altarpieces, one of which dates back to the 15th century and is carved from granite. Listed historic monument, it features an interesting fantasy bestiary.

Way of the cross in Callac

57 life-size granite statues comprise the Way of the cross in Callac, Plumelec. Some weigh nearly two tons ! Created in the 1950s at the instigation of Father Binard and thanks to the tireless work of local residents, the site also includes a replica of the Lourdes grotto, a chapel, three crosses, an esplanade, and a well.

Nature activities

Looking for a breathtaking view accessible only on foot, on horseback or by bike in the middle of the Landes de Lanvaux ?

From an unsuspected fishing spot at the edge of a 1st category river ?
Want to relax in the forest during a family walk ?

Let yourself be surprised by the diversity of nature activities offered in the Centre Morbihan.



Hiking

Explore the 16 marked **«Petite Randonnée»** (short hike) loops (yellow markings), covering more than 170 km, to discover the Centre Morbihan. There's something for all levels, from the easiest to the most difficult, from 3.5 km to 16.5 km.

GR38

Take a road trip to the heart of the Landes de Lanvaux, along the **GR38** hiking trail.

Cycling

Discover the local heritage by bike with the **Vélo Promenades®** (bike roads). Seven loops to explore the Centre Morbihan region by bike following secure roads (hybrid bike recommended).

The routes are available on the website and at the Tourist Office.

Fishing

Several fishing spots in **category 1 rivers**, the Evel, the Tarun and the Claie, are a paradise for trout fishermen from March to October. Some **ponds**, such as those in Bignan and Moréac for example, are accessible with a fishing license.

Mountain biking

For thrill-seekers, **the reliefs and paths** of Centre Morbihan are perfect for mountain biking. Many trails are suitable for this sport!

Equibreizh

For horse lovers, the Landes de Lanvaux are crossed by the Equibreizh, and there are many around 2 hours rides **local loops**.

Trail running

Three trail routes, ranging from 13 to 17.4 km, will take you on a **series of single-track trails and sunken paths**. Numbered 90 to 92, these circuits, located in the towns of Bignan and Locminé, will take you on a journey of discovery of the Domaine de Kerguéhennec, the Landes de Lanvaux, and the Tarun Valley.

Callac's Castle

From the outskirts of the castle, you can see the 15th century "towers' wing." This facade is very unusual, probably unique in its kind, with its four aligned round towers. A 14th century tower, the oldest part of the castle, the 16th century wing currently under restoration, the entrance, and the courtyard are all worth a visit.

The grounds of Callac Castle are accessible year-round. Guided tours are regularly organized according to a schedule available on the website. Callac's Castle is open for the European Heritage Days. Admission is free.

The association bought and renovated the ruined house where Pierre Guillemot was born in 1759, in order to evoke what a wealthy peasant's farm might have been like at the end of the 18th century, with its thatched roof and basic furniture. The association wanted the cottage to become a museum where exhibitions about the Chouannerie and local history have been held every summer for the past few years.

Open during summer and special events. For groups, 15 people minimum, all year, by appointment. Free entrance. Free or accompanied visit.

Nature, heritage and contemporary art meet at Kerguéhennec Estate. At the heart of a 45-hectare natural area with an arboretum, ponds and forests, discover the sculpture park, a reference place for the presentation of contemporary sculpture. Created in 1986, **this park now brings together more than thirty works by major artists.** From Mimi, a giant character by Markus Raetz to Sentier de charme by Giuseppe Penone, and including the Seven columns by Stéphane Mallarmé by Etienne Haidu. Several works designed to be walkable invite visitors to a different experience.

The castle, listed historic monument, is currently undergoing restoration and will reopen its doors in 2027 to better welcome you.

The park is open daily, year-round. Free admission. Pets are allowed on a leash in the park.
